




The Red Line between NoMa-Gallaudet U and Fort Totten will shut down from Saturday, October 29 through Tuesday, November 22.

Do you use the Red Line at NoMa-Gallaudet U Metrorail Station? Plan ahead for this major disruption.

What's happening:

- There will be no Red Line service between NoMa-Gallaudet U and Fort Totten.
- Red Line trains will run in two segments:
 - Shady Grove - NoMa-Gallaudet U
 - Glenmont - Fort Totten
-  Brookland-CUA and Rhode Island Ave stations will be closed.
- Free shuttle buses will replace trains between Fort Totten, Brookland-CUA, Rhode Island Ave and NoMa-Gallaudet U stations.

Plan ahead:

- Allow extra travel time and expect crowding on all trains due to much less frequent rush hour Red Line service.
- Use the Green Line for travel between Fort Totten and Gallery Place.
- Consider using multiple alternates to determine the best travel option.

Students using NoMa-Gallaudet U Metrorail Station often travel to and from the following Stations. Consider the following alternates to the Red Line:

Station	Travel Alternatives
Anacostia	Metrobus route 90 or 92 or Green Line to Gallery Place Metrorail Station (transfer to Red Line or Metrobus route 80* to route 90 or 92)
Benning Road	Metrobus route U8 (transfer to route X3) or Metrobus route U8 (transfer to route X2 or X9, then transfer to route 90)
Capitol Heights	Metrobus route X9 (transfer to route 90 or 92)
Columbia Heights	Metrobus route 90 or 92 (transfer to route 52, 53 or 54) or Metrobus route 90 or 92 (transfer to Green Line at U Street Metrorail Station)
Congress Heights	Metrobus route 92 or Green Line to Gallery Place Metrorail Station (transfer to Red Line) or Green Line to Gallery Place Metrorail Station (transfer to Metrobus route 80*)
Foggy Bottom-GWU	Blue, Orange or Silver Lines to Metro Center Metrorail Station (transfer to Metrobus route 80* or P6*, then transfer to route 90 or 92) or Georgetown-Union Station Circulator (transfer to route 80* or P6*, then transfer to route 90 or 92)
Fort Totten	Metrobus route 90 or 92 (transfer to route 80*) or Metrobus route 90 or 92 (transfer to Green Line at U Street Metrorail Station)
Georgia Ave-Petworth	Metrobus route 90 or 92 (transfer to Green Line at U Street Metrorail Station) or Metrobus route 90 or 92 (transfer to route 70 or 79)
Rhode Island Ave	Metrobus route 90, 92 or X3 (transfer to route D8) or Metrobus route 90, 92 or X3 (transfer to route P6*)
Tenleytown-AU	Metrobus route 90 or 92 (transfer to route 96) If the Red Line is too crowded at NoMa, take Metrobus route 80* to Metro Center Metrorail Station to get on the Red Line.

* Enhanced service will be provided on these routes. Check wmata.com for schedules.
