




The Red Line between NoMa-Gallaudet U and Fort Totten will shut down from Saturday, October 29 through Tuesday, November 22.

Do you use the Red Line at Tenleytown-AU Metrorail Station? Plan ahead for this major disruption.

What's happening:

- There will be no Red Line service between NoMa-Gallaudet U and Fort Totten.
- Red Line trains will run in two segments:
 - Shady Grove - NoMa-Gallaudet U
 - Glenmont - Fort Totten
-  Brookland-CUA and Rhode Island Ave stations will be closed.
- Free shuttle buses will replace trains between Fort Totten, Brookland-CUA, Rhode Island Ave and NoMa-Gallaudet U stations.

Plan ahead:

- Allow extra travel time and expect crowding on all trains due to much less frequent rush hour Red Line service.
- Use the Green Line for travel between Fort Totten and Gallery Place.
- Consider using multiple alternates to determine the best travel option.

Students using Tenleytown-AU Metrorail Station often travel to and from the following Stations. Consider the following alternates to the Red Line:

Station	Travel Alternatives
Anacostia	Green Line to Columbia Heights Metrorail Station (transfer to Metrobus route H2, H3 or H4) To avoid crowding at Gallery Place Metrorail Station, take the Green Line to L'Enfant Plaza Metrorail Station, transfer to Blue, Silver or Orange Lines, then transfer to Red Line at Metro Center Metrorail Station. Or Metrobus route 90 (transfer to 96)
Benning Road	Blue or Silver Line to the Red Line at Metro Center Metrorail Station or Blue or Silver Line to Farragut West Metrorail Station (transfer to Metrobus route 31, 33, 30N or 30S) or Metrobus route 96
Brookland-CUA	Metrobus route H2, H3 or H4
Dupont Circle	Metrobus route 96
Fort Totten	Metrobus route E4 (transfer to route M4, 31, 33, 30N or 30S) or Green Line to Columbia Heights Metrorail Station (transfer to Metrobus route H2, H3 or H4)
Potomac Ave	Blue, Orange or Silver Line to Red Line at Metro Center Metrorail Station or Blue, Orange or Silver Line to Farragut West Metrorail Station (transfer to route 31, 33, 30N or 30S)
Rhode Island Ave	Metrobus route H8 or D8 (transfer to route H2, H3 or H4)
Union Station	Metrobus route 96 If the Red Line is too crowded at NoMa, take Metrobus route 80* to Metro Center Metrorail Station to get on the Red Line.
Van Ness-UDC	Metrobus route H2
Woodley Park	Metrobus route 96
